“NOVICES INDOOR TOURNAMENT”

Saturday 2nd March 2019

Open to any Gloucestershire Club Member, Senior or Junior, who has completed a Beginners Course after June 2013 and has no Archery GB classification. Bow types are restricted to Recurve, Compound, Barebow and Longbow. The Tournament will be run to Archery GB Rules. The RESULTS will be announced at the end of the day, GAS Medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each bow discipline. The RESULTS will also be published on the GAS website.

The Round will be a Portsmouth (5doz at 20 yards on 60cm faces). Juniors may opt to shoot at 10 yards. AM Assembly 9.00am, Sighters 9.15am. PM Assembly 1.00pm, Sighters 1.15pm.

There will be a Morning (AM) and an Afternoon (PM) session, please indicate choice on Entry Form. Only one session per Archer. In the event of too few Entries, all will shoot in the Morning only. This venue is accessed by stairs and is therefore not suitable for wheelchair users.

Venue: Cheltenham Archers Indoor Range at Lansdown Industrial Estate, by Cheltenham Station.

Entry Fee: £10.00 per person, all ages.

All Juniors must be accompanied by a parent, or their nominee. Those wishing to shoot at 10yds please indicate on Entry Form.

Tea, Coffee, Soft Drinks and biscuits will be available.

Closing date for entries Mon 25th Feb 2019.

Data Protection:

Tournament Regulations

Archery GB Membership	Entrants must declare their Archery GB membership number on the entry form and membership cards must be shown when registering on the day. Failure to do so will result in you not being allowed to shoot.
Drug testing	All archers will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers by signing the entry form.
Dress Regulation Rule 307	For record status events there are dress regulations in place that have to be followed by all competitors. These are set out in the Rules of Shooting, but can be summarised as: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tops must cover the front and back of the body (that is, they are not strapless).• Any colour clothing is permitted, except for blue denim, olive drab, and camouflage patterns.• Plain or archery-related clothing is recommended.• Footwear must cover the whole foot (no open-toed sandals or shoes are allowed).
Special Note	Please ensure that the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have. Please do not assume that we already know. Archers who are unable to get to the target are requested to arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, then please contact the organiser for advice.
Lost Arrows	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.
Photography	In view of the provisions of the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the tournament organiser. Gloucestershire Archery Society will take all steps to ensure that photographs are only used for the purposes they are intended.
Smoking	We are bound by Archery GB smoking policy which says no smoking on the sports fields. Please ask the tournament organiser if there is a smoking area. Please note that this rule applies to those using electronic cigarettes or vaping.
General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)	When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with Tournament Organisers: For example target lists and results to be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow Style, Age Category, Club, Round, Disabled (Y/N). Juniors date of birth, used for checking correct round shot. Contact information such as email, addresses & phone numbers will not be published and only available to the Tournament Organiser to enable them to contact the archer if required to do so. The information supplied will be held no longer than two years after the event so the Tournament Organiser can publish results from that year and contact entrants the following year with the tournament information or for the return of any trophies won.
